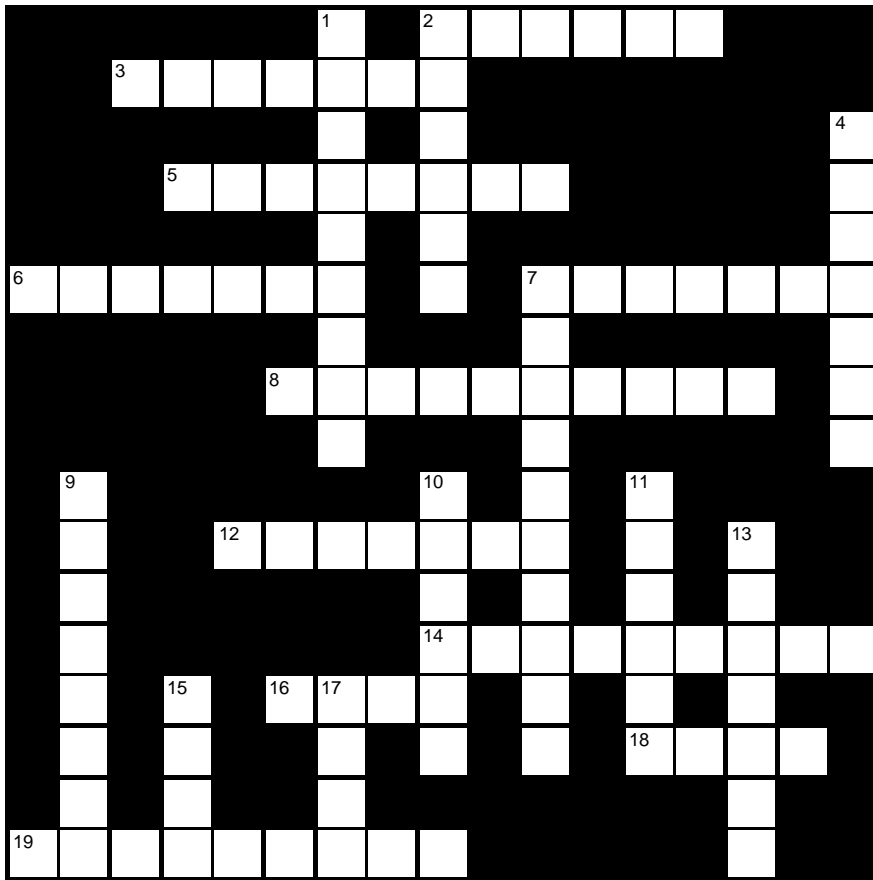


River and Wind Words – Crossword Puzzle

- 2 Sudden violent winds; often accompanied by precipitation (6)
- 3 A steep descent of the water of a river (7)
- 5 Water mixed with waste matter (8)
- 6 The occurrence of a water flow resulting from sudden rain or melting snow (7)
- 7 A mechanical device that blows air onto a fire to make it burn more fiercely (7)
- 8 A place where two things come together (10)
- 12 A violent rotating windstorm (7)
- 14 A branch that flows into the main stream (9)
- 16 Flat surface that rotates and pushes against air or water (4)
- 18 A miniature whirlpool or whirlwind resulting when the current of a fluid doubles back on itself (4)
- 19 Expose to cool or cold air so as to cool or freshen (9)

- 1 A powerful circular current of water (usually the resulting of conflicting tides) (9)
- 2 A very fine rain that falls from a clear sky at dusk (6)
- 4 A seasonal wind in S Asia; blows from the SW (bringing rain) in summer and from the NE in winter (7)
- 7 Blow hard; be gusty, as of wind (10)
- 9 Fill or cover completely, usually with water (8)
- 10 A powerful circular current of water (usually the resulting of conflicting tides) (6)
- 11 A heavy rain (6)
- 13 To move or cause to move in a sinuous, spiral, or circular course: the river winds through the hills. (7)
- 15 Blow gently (4)
- 17 A sensation (as of a cold breeze or bright light) that precedes the onset of certain disorders such as a migraine attack or epileptic seizure (4)
